

Latest on Florida as of 25 minutes ago:

“By a vote of 29-11, the Florida Senate passed [its version of HB 969](#) – [no private right of action] -- and sent the bill back to the House for consideration of the rewritten version.

At this point, there are only two legislative options remaining:

- (1) the House passes it without any changes, or
- (2) no privacy law is adopted in Florida during this legislative session.

There is not enough time for the House to change the law again and have Senate reconsider/pass it by tomorrow. The odds are high that the House will pass HB 969 tomorrow and Governor DeSantis will sign it.”
